## **Our Programs**

### Spay/Neuter

Our Low Cost Mobile Spay and Neuter clinic performed surgeries on more than **5,000** animals over the past three years. Studies show that the prevention of overpopulation is far more efficient and cost-effective than euthanasia and prevents animals from entering the more costly and difficult shelter system.



### Low-Income Supplemental Pet Food Distribution Program

AnimalSave's Low Income Supplemental Pet Food Distribution Program is intended to help individuals and families keep their pets during these challenging economic times by providing supplemental food for their companion animals. AnimalSave distributes over **30,000** pounds of pet food each year.

### Foster/Adoption Program

This program combats animal abuse, neglect, and unnecessary euthanasia by rescuing hundreds of homeless dogs and cats. We place rescued animals into volunteer foster homes until they find their forever homes. AnimalSave finds loving homes for **350** cat and dogs each year. Our Cat Adoption Room inside the thrift store houses cats available for adoption.

### Trap/Neuter/Release (TNR)

TNR is a proven procedure in which entire colonies of stray and feral cats are humanely trapped spayed or neutered and then released. This method of population control is more effective than trap-and-kill. AnimalSave spays/neuters over **400** feral cats each year!
